Adlerian therapy is a positive psychology and approach to therapy that emphasizes prevention, optimism and hope, resilience and growth, competence, creativity and resourcefulness, social consciousness, and finding meaning and a sense of community in relationships

people seek their goals in many ways In sum, the Adlerian position is cognitive, with a constructivist viewpoint "Adler's theory emphasizes that the person is an active, creative agent in the construction of his own personality, not merely a passive reactor shaped by his environment" (Shulman, 1985, p 243)

Existential perspectives and cognitive behavioral therapy for an individual In existential therapy the state of con-sciousness is always defined in relation to the external world Being-in-world, a key principle, is especially to the practice of therapy; it stresses that people exist only in the context of the world and others (Binswanger 1963)
